Angela was born on November 15, 1958, to the late Clarence Thomas and Dorothy Lee White in Newport News, VA. She grew up in New Haven, CT, where she attended Sheridan Middle School and graduated from Hillhouse High School in 1976. In the 1980's, Angela Thomas married Danny Dixon, and together they welcomed their daughter, Kenya. Angela Dixon later had two sons, Louis and Adam. She was an employee of Yale New-Haven Hospital, Stop & Shop, and she worked as a Certified Nursing Assistant before her retirement.

Sister Angela was a lifelong member of the United House of Prayer For All People, actively participating in various auxiliaries, including the McCollough Maids, Bailey Lifelines, and the Cunningham Sr. Queens.

Known affectionately as "Winky," Sister Dixon was especially recognized for her role on the United Inspirational Singers (UIS). She cherished her involvement with the UIS and was a vibrant and animated tenor during performances. Despite facing numerous health challenges, Sister Angela never allowed them to hinder her passion for singing in the choir. Whether using a cane, walker, or oxygen tank, she consistently sang to glorify God.

In addition to her passion for singing, Angela had a deep love for cooking, often preparing full meals late at night or in the early hours of the morning. She was an avid traveler, always eager for a road trip, especially to Virginia to

spend time with her grandchildren. In her earlier years, she enjoyed sewing and crocheting, but above all, she treasured moments shared with her family.

Angela is preceded in death by her parents and her husband. She is survived by her children: Kenya Wynn (Rodney), Louis Dixon, and Adam Dixon (Byanka), who will hold her memory dear; as well as her brother, Louis A. Cox (Leslie); seven grandchildren: Christopher Dixon, Tyler and Kyra Wynn, Aaliya, Adam Jr., and Amir Dixon, Zyauna Highsmith; two nieces, Emma and Sasha Cox; along with a multitude of relatives and friends too numerous to mention.
