August 10, 1933 - September 19, 2022

Departed this life with his wife at his bedside on Monday, September 19, 2022, in New Haven,

CT. Born in Georgetown, SC on Thursday, August 10, 1933, to the late Samuel and Hannah

(Small) Beauford and received his education in the Plantersville School System. Cain lived in

Plantersville until he moved to Indianapolis, IN after which he relocated to New Haven, CT.

Once moving to Connecticut in October of 1972, he became employed as a Polisher Operator at

Sargent Manufacturing Co. in New Haven, CT, where he was employed for twenty-six (26) years

until his retirement May of 1999.

While working at Sargent, Cain was invited to Union Temple FWB Church by Sis. Dorothy Gregg where after a few joyful visits he became a member then six months later after joining met the love of his life Reverend Barbara J.

Greene and asked her for her hand in marriage. On Saturday, December 19, 1981, the two became one, and would have celebrated 40 years together on Dec. 19, 2022.

Cain loved his family and was the patriarch of the Beauford family tree as well as the last living uncle. He loved to travel up the highway to Pittsburg along with his nephew Bernard Tucker, Sr. every chance he got to see his family.

Cain was a very cool and classy dresser, whenever you seen him, he would either have on a baseball cap or one of his dress hats depending on what occasion was along with his toothpick in his mouth.
