Saint Johnson was born on August 26, 1930 in Augusta, Georgia to her parents, the late Roxie Price and Malachi Tolbert. She was the oldest of three children. Her mother moved to Brooklyn, NY when Christine was 7 years old. The family lived on Atlantic Avenue for many years. They attended the United House of Prayer in Brooklyn #1 which was located at 184 Fulton Street. They later relocated to 25 Sumpter Street also in Brooklyn, NY.

St. Johnson was blessed to receive the blessed gift of the Holy Ghost in the Floodgate under our Founder, Sweet Daddy Grace.

In 1947, she married Bro. Reuben Johnson. To their uniting, nine children were born.

With her faith intact, St. Johnson changed her membership to Brooklyn #2 located on Fulton Street. Somewhere around 1964, she joined Brooklyn #3

located at 420 Hinsdale Street, under the pastoralship of Apostle J.L. Hicks. This is where she really grew spiritually. Her way of life was Fasting, Praying and Tarrying around the Holy Mountain. Her prayer partners were Saint Royester Hicks (Dollbaby), Saint Isabel Segers, Saint Balorie Johnson, Saint Missionary Deborah Stevenson and others. She loved studying the Bible and living it. She taught us that serving God was beneficial for our souls.

She enjoyed selling her homemade ice cream, making sweet potato pies, selling sodas and making barbecue ribs. She also enjoyed doing flea markets. She was one of the greatest drum beaters at Brooklyn #3. She started a youth choir with the young people of Brooklyn #3 and she gathered some children from the neighborhood to participate. She enjoyed getting out in the streets to talk to people. She always taught to talk to anyone no matter how they looked. Her work in the House of Prayer afforded her various positions such as, President of President, Youth President, President of the Young Adult Ushers, Treasurer and Nanny to all the children. She taught the young people in her natural and spiritual family to live to please God and His manservant. Saint Missionary Christian Johnson loved giving praises to God. Even when her health began to fail, she would still find a way to give God his praises by clapping her hands, stomping her feet or just shedding tears.

Saint Missionary Christine Johnson is preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Bro. Reuben Johnson, her son, Bro.
