Daniella Janae Davis, 35, of North Haven, CT passed away Thursday February 6, 2025 after a courageous battle with cancer. Danielle or Danni, as she was called by those close to her, was born November 18, 1989 at St. Raphael Hospital in New Haven. She spent her formative years growing up in West Haven, CT with her mom, Dorothy Davis, her Grandmother Carolyn Davis and grandfather Charles Davis. While growing up in West Haven, she attended Forest Elementary School and Carrigan Middle School, where she enjoyed playing basketball.
