David was ordained to be a Minister on October 15, 2006 by Apostle Gary Jenkins, of Sword of the Spirit Ministres. He was currently a member of Christian Love Center Church, Inc, under the leadership of his beloved Pastor, Overseer Wille Mae Clayton, where he was a part of the CLC Male Chorus.

David was annointed, appointed and equipped by God. He was gifted with revelational knowledge of the word and the ability to translate it to others. He walked in the prophetic anointing and could auditorily hear from the Lord.

Some time ago Pastor Timothy Maybanks held a service called "From the streets to the Pulpit" and had asked David to minister. That very title became the mantra and testimony of his life.
