Delores Moore Knight, 75, of New Haven, CT passed away suddenly on April 4, 2020. She was born on 11/29/1944 in Southport, NC to Ruth Moore Walker. She attended school in Wilmington, NC and graduated from Williston High School in 1962. At that time she migrated north to Philadelphia, PA and eventually to New Haven, CT where she remained for the remainder of her life.

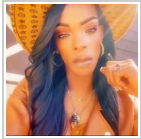

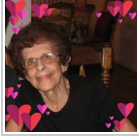
