He worked at Winchester Repeating Arms for more then 27 years and Safety Electric for 10 years before retiring in 1990. A World War II veteran receiving an honorable discharge in 1953. He was a member of Widows Son Lodge #1 P.H. A. Mr. Johnson was a member of Immanuel Missionary Baptist Church, serving on the Boards of Deacons, and President of the Men's Club. He also served as an ombudsman for the New Haven Club of The National Association of The Negro Business and Professional Women's Club.
