Minister Fred Hogan Jr. of New Haven, CT departed this life Saturday August 19, 2017. He was born October 20, 1952 in Waterbury, CT. He is the eldest son of Fred Hogan Sr. (deceased) and Sadie Mae Hardy. Minister Hogan is the husband of Overseer Susan R. Hogan. The two have been faithfully married for over 40 years.

The Hogans have been blessed with eight children: Jonathan Hogan (Roxanne, Kirsten, Adias), Chenik Arrington (Danielle, De'Ara, Dezyre-deceased), Dominique Arrington (Kevona), Thomas Arrington, Marquis "Josh" Arrington, Daniel Hogan (Nevaeh), Ashley Hogan (Mya, Anthony, Michael Jr.), and Brandon Hogan. 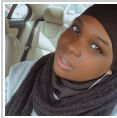

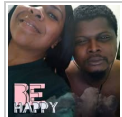

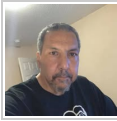
