



## Gabriel Yalartai

March 10, 1981 - December 26, 2021

Gabriel Yalartai, 40, died unexpectedly at the Oklahoma City Detention Center, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on December 26, 2021. Gabriel became mentally ill while living in Chicago in 2009. He was born March 10, 1981, in Liberia, West Africa, the son of Moses Ben Yalartai and Ma Lucky (commonly called Ma Maylar) Yalartai.

Gabriel was hard-working; he loved life, traveling, and music, and he wanted to be a rap artist.

Gabriel attended the World-Wide Mission School in Monrovia, Liberia in 1995. Due to the Liberian Civil War, Gabriel fled to Ghana in 1999, along with many of his siblings. In 2001, Gabriel arrived in the U.S. along with many of his siblings as refugees. In 2002, Gabriel attended the New Haven Adult Education Center in New Haven, Connecticut.

Gabriel grew up in a polygamy family; for his father was a town chief with many wives and children.

He was predeceased by his father, Moses Ben Yalartai, brothers Sayon and Samuel, and sister Kingyneu.

He leaves to mourn his 17-year old son, Avante Gabriel Yalartai, his loving

and caring mother, Ma Lucky, in Liberia, a host of siblings (including Bishop Harmon D. Yalartai (Esther), Bennett M. Yalartai (Varnelle P. Marshall), Wilmot B. Yalartai (Beatrice), Saturday B. Yalartai, Nathaniel Yalartai, Thomas W.
