He wrote his first song at the age of 6 entitled “Go God’s Way”, which his family would sing together during family worship. Isaiah chose to attend a Performing Arts school where he honed his musical talents and was selected to perform his own music at his graduation ceremony.

Isaiah performed on stages in many local venues in New Haven county, New York, and Martha’s Vineyard.

The New Haven radio station, WYBC, invited Isaiah to speak about the Travon Martin murder, when the nation was grieving this atrocity.

Isaiah loved his family and friends, especially his son and daughter. He leaves to cherish his memory his beloved children Mansai and Zayloni South, his loving mother Sojournah South, sisters Micaiah and Wisdom South, brothers Elijah, Justice, and Judah South, grandmother Maxine Thompson, and a host of aunts, uncles, cousins, friends and loved ones.
