On Saturday, January 21, 2023, Jacob Beasley, beloved husband of Jeanetta transitioned to his new home. He was seventy-four years old. He was born to David and Wilhelmena Beasley in Beaufort County, South Carolina, on August 8, 1948.

Joe graduated from Robert Smalls High School in Beaufort County, South Carolina. Joe maintained two jobs; he owned a painting company named J & J Painting for 15 years along with being employed at Connecticut State Mental Health where he retired. He worked tirelessly for his family with love. Joe and Jeanetta had been married for 50 years.

He was soft-spoken with a loving and kind personality. He was affectionately known as Joe/Dreamboat. Joe was dedicated to his family. He had a great sense of humor. Joe loved God with a deep reverence that showed in the many years of service given to Christ. He rededicated his life to Christ 40 years ago and was a legend in walking with his wife in ministry by faith for 36 years. Joe served as Chairman Deacon and Church Administrator at Living Water Gospel Church. When Joe discovered he was ill, he told family members, "I have done everything I wanted to do in life, I have traveled the world, seen places I never dreamt I would visit, I have served the Lord and now I am just sitting waiting for the man above to call, I am well with everything."
