Jonquay Terrell Morrison was born in New Haven, CT on February 16, 1983 to the late Johnnie Morrison III (Deceased), and Dena & Maceo Patton. He attended the former Martin Luther King School and Jackie Robinson School of New Haven, and graduated with a high school diploma from Riverside Education Academy, New Haven, CT. He was most recently employed as a residential manager at the Columbus House, New Haven.

Jonquay's life as a young man did not always take him on a path that would serve him well. But those who knew him knew that Jonquay would be able to make the best out of any situation. He could light a room with just his smile, and his jovial nature would warm the coldest heart. Many friends, acquaintances and strangers were recipients of his kind and generous nature, checking on the well-being of his friends, assisting anyone he knew who was in need, regardless of how long he knew you. If you needed something and he had it that meant you had it, or he would go get it, asking nothing in return. And if you were friends with Jonquay, he never stayed angry with you very long. He may be in an argument with you one minute, and laughing and joking with you the next ... like nothing happened. And with nicknames like 'Quay 2-4000' and 'Dough-Boy', you know he could be counted on to bring the funk and the fun! He spent much time at the home of his grandmother on West Ivy Street, and was known to be able to pull 'the crew' together to celebrate life, whether it was friends or family. He loved being in the presence of good

people and having good fun. He also thought he had some pretty good culinary skills; he would cook up special meals and then send photos of his creations to his mother and try to compare them! Jonquay loved to ride motorcycles and particularly enjoyed the 3-wheeled Spiders! And his passion for sneakers was evidenced by the numbers in his collection would reached over 150 pairs.
