Kenneth M. Brown Sr. of West Haven, CT departed this mortal life September 1, 2022. He was born June 22, 1962 in Long Island, New York to Eric J. Brown and Maggie Nelson-Staggers.

Throughout Kenneth's life journey, he worked hard to provide for his family so that they would have the tools needed to be successful. He lost his mother at a young age, so he had to grow up quickly to ensure his younger siblings had what they needed. His life experiences were his lessons that he shared with his children and siblings often. He wanted more for his siblings and children, so he stressed the value of education, knowledge and the importance of hard work. He was a role model and a leader in every room he stepped in. His presence added value and strength.

Kenneth worked at Yale University in Calhoun Dining Hall for over thirty years as a chef. He loved cooking in the fast pace kitchen. He believed in fairness and what was right. It was no surprise that he was a force during the strike of 1996 at Yale University. Kenneth served as the union steward during the strike and negotiated with university leaders for better benefits for the staff in all dining halls. He also worked the summers at JCC Camp Kingswood in Bridgeton, Maine as a chef, where he would bring his children. Kenny Jr. loved the camp. His sisters would always tease him that his vernacular would change after a day or two of being with friends in the cabins. Kenneth would share the biggest grin whenever his children shared an accomplishment. He bragged about them often. He taught them the power of prayer and showed

through example what it means to truly love Christ. Through daily bible readings and explanations of bible principles on Love and forgiveness, Kenneth wanted to ensure his children understood what it took to develop personal faith and share the love of Christ with all people. Each life experience generated a lesson that will forever be engrained in them. His dedication to his faith and sharing the love of Christ was honored when he was appointed to serve as a Deacon.

Kenneth is survived by his five daughters Erin Brown-Summers, Erika Brown-Hickerson (Rashee), Ebonee Brown (Brandon), Whitney Nichols-Haywood (Steven) and Miya Brown, his grandchildren, his brothers Eric Brown (Bernice), Anthony Brown, David Flewellen-Brown, Roosevelt Bowen, his sisters Barbara Dupree, Karen Brown, and Sharon Brown (Devon).
