His number one show was "word party". He knew every scene, episode, and song. He would dance throughout the entire show.

There is nothing like a mother's love. He showed this every day. His face was always full of joy. He enjoyed taking selfies, doing tiktok videos with her, and showing her his dance moves or just cuddling.

He loved his time with his dad. He would run to him so that he can flip him all day. That was his daily routine. He would jump on his dad until he flipped him numerous of times and play with him as soon as he wake up or just cuddle. He enjoyed his daily walks to the park with his parents.

Besides spending time with his parents, Legend love to visit his Gammy Trese house, that was his special place to go. There, he would see his other relatives and hang out with his aunty Khloe. They were kind of like Besties. They would take pics soon as he walked through the door, start playing with his toys, and being silly. Peek-a-boo was their favorite game to play. Legend got a kick out of that game.

Legend, had a favorite chair at his Gammy house. The only place he would sit. It was Curious George something like a big teddy bear. He would show everyone who walked in the house his chair. Often he love to pick up his chair and throw it at his pop pop (Marco) to get him to play with him. He would laugh like he was having the time of his life.

Legend, love to stack blocks, paint, and draw with his markers. He would stack his blocks as high as they would go until they fall over and he would rebuild it every time. He enjoyed playing with his cousin McKenna. She would do whatever he wanted to do. They would sit in the middle of the floor and play until he leaves to go home.

Legend was the joy of our lives. He will truly be missed.

Legend suffered from a rare genetic disease called Gaucher 3. He was recently diagnosed back in July 2023 following a dramatic respiratory incident. The disease affects the organs, cardiovascular, and respiratory system which weaken the muscles and makes it harder to breathe, cough things up, or swallow. Although legend was doing well, internally the disease was causing him to be very ill in a way that was hard for ourselves and medical staff to physically see. Which made his death traumatic and unexpected.

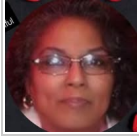
