On February 7, 2020 shortly before noon, Luciano Rubio inhaled his last breath on this earth and entered into the glory of his Lord.

He fought a long and brave battle with his varying illnesses. Friday he went home with joy in his heart to spend his last week surrounded by the people he loved most, his caring wife, Mari and children, Elias, Jonatan, Priscilla and Caleb.

Through out the years his family's strong faith and perseverance is what kept a him alive. His family is what meant most to him. His wife and kids are what motivated him to keep fighting the everyday battle with the unbearable pain from cancer. He was an inspirational figure within the ministry for more than 30 years. Reverend Rubio worked with Teen Challenge, a Christian faith-based corporations intended to help teenagers, adults, and families with problems such as substance abuse or self-destructive behavior. He held many positions throughout his time there: director, counselor, leader, teacher, mentor and coordinator of the Teen Challenge in South America. During his time in the Teen Challenge in Brockton, Massachusetts he worked alongside Pastor Rodney preparing students to become leaders. In various cities within Paraguay he uplifted and opened Teen Challenge centers to help young adults within the community. He led conferences bringing awareness about addiction with the solution being Jesus. In Connecticut Teen Challenge he

was able to be the director of the New haven center as he counseled and mentored many students during their journey seeking faith. After becoming disabled, he continued to speak life into everyone he knew.

After 63 years of living, he left a profound example of what a Father, Husband and Leader ought to be. He will be greatly missed by those who loved him but his legacy continues to live on through his family.
