Mama had a great love and special love for children, not just her grand's and great grand's, but every child she came in contact with. Mama would treat every child with the same love and concern for their well-being whether she knew you for 5 minutes or 10 years.

Mama had a great love for sports and especially Emmitt Smith whom she met in person while working for Starter. Mr. Smith would come to her department with a new picture every time he came to town. She had many autographed pictures of him all over her house.

Mama was also known to walk everywhere she went, it was next to impossible to get her to take a ride.
