Savon Tallman, age 28, passed away on Saturday, October 16, 2021 in Waterbury, Connecticut. Savon was born on May 11, 1993, in Danbury Connecticut, to Tracy Edmonds and the late Elbert Nicholas Bellamy. Savon Tallman spent most of his younger life in Danbury, CT, attending Danbury Public Schools and graduated from Danbury High School.
