Terrence Lamont “Moon-Man” Jackson, Sr., 52, of New Haven, the loving son of the late Carolyn Stevenson and the late Albert C. Jackson, Jr., entered suddenly into eternal rest on Wednesday, November 2, 2022, at his home.

Terrence was born November 13, 1969, in New Haven. He attended New Haven Public Schools. He spent several years in Atlanta and returned to the New Haven area in 2021.

In Atlanta, Terrence was employed at CNN and Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport. At the time of his death, Terrence was employed by Pro Park at Yale-New Haven Hospital. Terrence enjoyed creating podcasts and music and spending time with his family and friends.

Terrence is survived by his devoted wife, Phyllis Hansberry Jackson of New Britain; three children, daughter Sherina Jones of New Haven, sons Markese Bradshaw of New Haven and Terrence Jackson, Jr. of Middletown. Terrence also leaves one grandson, Makai Bradshaw of New Haven.
