Theodore Rockfeller Pullen Jr., was the son of the late Theodore Rockfeller Pullen Sr. and Mary Magdalene Alston Pullen. He was born on December 17, 1940 in Littleton, North Carolina and departed this life to enter his heavenly life on Sunday, July 26, 2015, at St. Raphael Hospital, New Haven, Connecticut.

He accepted Christ at an early age, and joined Lees Chapel Baptist Church, in Littleton, North Carolina.

After attending elementary school in Warren County, North Carolina and Graduating High School from John R.
