



## Theodore Roosevelt Salters Sr.

August 2, 1927 - August 10, 2018

Mr. Theodore Roosevelt Salters, Sr. of McDonough, GA; formerly of New Haven, CT; went home to be with the Lord on Friday, August 10, 2018, at the age of 91. He was the widower of Mrs. Jimmie Mae Salters.

Mr. Salters was born on August 2, 1927 in Kingstree, SC to James Salters and Selma Scott Cooper. He and his family later moved to New Haven, CT. Mr. Salters worked at Winchester Repeating Arms Company for 30 years. He later worked for the City of New Haven as a crossing guard for 20 years.
