“ I found out over the weekend that Tracy Williams died. We grew up in a close-knit neighborhood where all of us hung out and looked out for each other. Tracy was a part of that crew and we've stayed tight like family from childhood. We spent hours on front porches playing the dozens -- him calling me yellow, me calling him black [you had to grow a thick skin to hang on our block]; we shared secrets and helped one another through hard times. We celebrated births and mourned deaths together.



I can see him running from El -- his mom -- as she reached out to clock him with her hockey stick [because she was too short and him too fast] when he did something wrong. I can hear him and Mr. Lee -- his dad -- laughing on the front porch as they told Gary to shut up [everyone told Gary -- his brother -- to shut up, always]. Tracy was like an older cousin who you hit up for cash and cigarettes. He was a confidant who you could share your fears with and know he'd keep them safe.

I am fortunate to have known Tracy and his spirit, and I am fortunate to have grown up in that community where even now we treat each other more like family than friends.

Here's to you Tracy Williams, know that the Winchester Ave. Crew will always keep you in our hearts so you will live on forever...
