Mother Verline worked over 40 years at SNET until it became SBC and retired before it converted to AT&T. She was the first African American female to be a Circuit Design Tech for SNET. She graduated from the University of New Haven.

Mother Verline was blessed to be elevated to the rank of Mother and held many offices, titles, and positions during her lifetime as a member of the church. At the time of her demise, she was a loving mother spiritually and naturally.

Mother Verline was also a caring and affectionate single parent to a host of foster children in the surrounding areas of New Haven and Hamden. The Lord blessed her to be able to adopt several children over the years. In addition to her generous spirit she exemplified a true meaning of an "Angel". Mother Verline opened her home to whoever was in the need of food or shelter.
